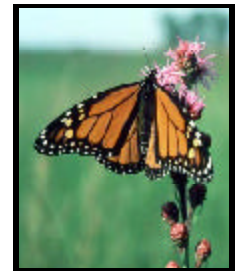
These status report sheets describe projects and programs that are being implemented in the Red River Basin that assist in carrying out the mission of the Red River Basin Commission.

Project Summary:

The Middle River/Snake River Watershed District has the opportunity to work with landowners, the National Audubon Society, MN DNR, BWSR, Soil and Water Conservation Districts and other local units of government to develop a multipurpose flood control and wildlife enhancement project near Warren, MN. The project covers approximately 4 sections of land in Marshall and Polk Counties. In addition to providing significant flood control benefits, the project provides substantial habitat and water quality benefits in an area that is primarily agricultural. These benefits include prairie habitat, woodland habitat, educational/recreational opportunities, research/demonstration areas and summer base flow augmentation on the Snake River.
